#### Motivation

In 2012, I connected with the internationally renowned street arts company, Zap Art, and we started to explore the meeting point of public art and theatre, inspired by working with, by and for communities. With ten productions over the last ten years, making professional place-making theatre with communities. Each show is inspired and informed by a local story of some kind. We collect people's stories and memories, offer creative workshops around the theme, and then I write a script played by professional and non professional artists.

BIGGEST CHALLENGE - The arts and community work in general has suffered from diminishing funding over the last ten years or so, despite evidence that that participating in arts and community activities increased wellbeing and a sense of belonging that is so crucial for both individuals and communities themselves.

#### **Achievements**

Very proud of the quality of the productions we create. We love telling intriguing stories that are accessible to a wide range of people.

The level of genuine community participation, which, in Newhaven has developed over ten years of working in the town.

Tidemills choir, here today, was part of our last show, and we loved working with them!

### **Beneficiaries**

- Hundreds of recipients over the last ten years. Most recently, we had 45 participants for Two Pairs of Eyes. Amazing local participation
  - Community theatre is about the process as much as the product. This has pulled out all the stops of bringing a group together and helping them to get to know each other. We leave here much more bonded than when we came and with a new confidence!
